Obtained M Com from M G University Kottayam, an MPhil from the University of Kerala and a PhD from the University of Calicut in 1996; he also has an MBA degree. He qualified for the UGC Junior Research Fellowship in 1992.

Prof Gabriel Simon has been teaching since 1991. An author of four books with numerous publications to his credit, he has acted as chair and invited speaker in several national and international seminars nationwide

Dr. Gabriel is the Vice-President of Indian Accounting Association. he has produced 31 PhDs and 50 M Phils and acted as the project coordinator for two major research projects of the Department of Commerce. He was the coordinator for the SAP-UGC project, coordinator for the innovative project of the Department and has executed significant consultancy work for Federal Bank on Behalf of the University.

He is a Governing Board Member of the Centre for Development Studies and editor of the Ramanujan International Journal of Business and Research (RIJBR), New Delhi. He also serves as the Dean of Commerce and Management Studies at Kannur University and a Senate member of the University of Kerala.
